

Due to the real, recent increase in positive COVID-19 Delta Variant diagnoses, St. Peter's has decided to suspend all in-person services for at least the next two Sundays: September 12 and September 19. We will continue to livestream our 11:00 AM service on our Facebook or YouTube page and to broadcast our 11:00 AM service on WKRM 103.7 FM with only our worship leaders present.

- Naturally Sunday School and our Nursery will be closed on those two Sundays as well
- Our Parish Administrator will be available to answer calls and emails during normal business hours over the next two weeks. However, the church office will be closed to in-person visits at least through Friday, September 24.

When we do return, we want to remind everyone who chooses to worship in-person at St. Peter's that, as always, we will continue to offer masks and hand sanitizer at the entrance of the church. We encourage their use by the vulnerable in our parish family—especially those who have chosen not to receive a vaccination.

We continue to pray for those infected with this virus to any degree: we also continue to pray for the medical professionals in practices, clinics, hospitals, and any other environment who care for those in need.
